**CONVENED:** 6:30 p.m.

**MICHELLE JENSEN - TO REQUEST A HOME OCCUPATION BUSINESS LICENSE FOR A SALON AT 355 NORTH 900 WEST.**

Michelle Jensen said she has built a house in Hyrum and wants to turn one of the rooms in the basement into a salon for artificial nails and eyelashes. She is State Licensed.

**ACTION** Councilmember James made a motion to approve Michelle Jensen's request for a Home Occupation Business License at 355 North 900 West for a salon. Councilmember Rasmussen seconded the motion and all five councilmembers voted aye.

**FRIEND WELLER - TO REPORT ON HIS LOW POWER RADIO SERVICE IN HYRUM.**

Friend Weller said last spring on April 5, 2012 the City Council made a motion to authorize him to submit an LPFM license application for Hyrum City when the FCC opens the filing window in 2012. If and when the FCC approves Hyrum City's application for an LPFM license the City will discuss funding for equipment and on-going costs at that time. January 2000, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) created a special class of radio licenses called Low Power FM Radio (LPFM) and was going to open a second filing window in the summer or fall of 2012, however, that didn't happen but should this October. In order to be eligible for an LPFM license the licensee must be a government or non-profit education institution or provides local public safety or transportation service. An individual or commercial entity cannot be issued an LPFM license. He will prepare documentation and have it ready to be turned into the FCC as soon as allowed.

***OTHER BUSINESS:***

**COMCAST CARES DAY.**

City Administrator D. Brent Jensen said due to weather conditions the City will not be able to complete the prep work necessary for work to begin at Blacksmith Park as part of Comcast Cares Day. He asked the City Council to consider other projects for that day.

The City Council suggested: CCC Camp - Planting trees, and development of campground spaces; Left Hand - Development of fire

pits, campground spaces, and building a fence; Salt Hollow Park - Planting of trees and installation of sod; Senior Center - Painting Interior; East Park - Spring maintenance of baseball diamonds; Canyon Park - Spring cleaning of limbs and debris; Entrance into City - Planting of trees; and City Square - Linseed on bowery. .

**APPROVAL OF YOUTH COUNCIL CHARTER.**

Councilmember Miller said the Youth Council reviewed the charter and is not recommending any changes to it. The City Council does not have to approve it since there are no amendments.

**MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL REPORTS.**

Councilmember Felix said the reopening of the Museum was held on January 12, 2013 there were a lot of people in attendance. The Hyrum Library Book and Bake Sale is February 8 and 9.

Councilmember James said soccer sign-ups are being held this month.

Councilmember Miller said the Youth Council will attend Local Officials Day at the Legislature. The Youth Council is also helping the Library with its Book and Bake Sale. January 26 is the Winter Festival at the Hyrum State Park. March 16 is Hyrum City's Princess Pageant. The Local Business Conference is on February 9 from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. she invited the Council to come and talk to business owners in Hyrum.
