HYRUM HISTORY BOOK – The new Hyrum History Book is in the process of being published. We are hoping to have it available to purchase before Christmas. We are super excited to finally have a record of the history of Hyrum from the 1970's to today. Special thanks to those who served on the committee or provided information to make this book possible. WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS – Winter parking restriction begin November 1st. Parking is not allowed on city streets or within ten feet of roadway pavement in any municipal right-of-way between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 8:00 a.m. unless such vehicle is in a driveway approach or otherwise parked behind the curb where curb exists. This law allows for snow removal and is in effect between November 1st and April 1st, even when there is no snow.

MUSEUM NEWS – On **Saturday, November 8th from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.** the museum will be hosting a **Veterans' Oral History Workshop** and everyone is invited! Have you seen the super cool veterans' scrapbook in the museum? Have you been meaning to complete a page for yourself, a family member, friend, or neighbor? Or, are you a veteran that has been meaning to record your story? Well, here is your opportunity! Bring down your pictures, information, and anything else you'd like to include and museum staff will be ready to help construct the page or conduct and record an oral interview with you! 12"x12" papers will be provided along with embellishments for scrapbook pages, plus we have recorders and questions ready to go. We are here to help you document your service! Additionally, the theme of our "Back in Time" children's activity this month is "Thanking Our Veterans!" Bring your kid(s) to the museum on **November 18th, 19th, or 20th** from 2:00-2:30 p.m. each day to hear the stories of our local heroes, talk to some veterans, and make a flag to display in our exhibit. Sign-up is preferred, but not required.

The museum has two new exhibits to enjoy! First, following the public exhibition of the Reflections Contest participants from Lincoln and Canyon Elementaries at the Elite Hall on November 5th and 6th, we will display the winning entries until the end of the year. Second, be sure to come see our final Community Exhibit of the year, a 1940s Nutcracker Christmas.

Please note that the museum will be closed **Tuesday November 11th** for Veterans Day and **Thursday November 27th and Saturday November 29th** for the Thanksgiving holiday.


